

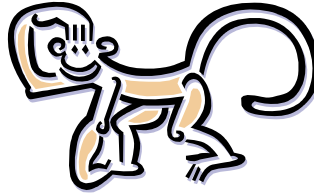


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These savory treats can be made in addition to re-reading *Caps for Sale* with Puppet Play.

Equipment:

Bunt pan
Bowls (small)
Small pan



Ingredients:

4 cans (10 biscuits each) refrigerated buttermilk biscuits
1 1/2 sticks of butter or margarine
3 cups brown sugar
4 tablespoons cinnamon

Directions:

- Combine the brown sugar and the cinnamon, divide the mixture in half and put it into two separate bowls.
- Melt one stick of butter or margarine in the small pan over low heat. (adult)
- Tear each biscuit into three pieces and roll into balls. Dip the balls in the melted butter and then into one bowl of the brown sugar and cinnamon mixture. Roll them around to coat evenly.
- Put into the ungreased Bunt pan.
- Melt, over low heat, the second half stick of butter with the brown sugar/cinnamon mixture. Pour evenly and immediately over the coated balls in the Bunt pan. (adult)
- Bake for 30 minutes in a 350 degree oven.
- Turn oven off. Let pan sit for 5 minutes, and then remove from oven and turn pan over on a serving plate.
- Let it sit for a few minutes upside down on the plate before removing the pan.
- Cool before serving.
