



• **Let's Count Together**

Not only is this a book about family and cooperation, but also about counting! Children love to count items. Together you can create a counting board. You will need a piece of poster board or cardboard, glue and different items to count. Items for counting could be pictures of food cut from magazines or real things like buttons, nuts, macaroni, rocks and anything else you can think of (keeping in mind that small objects are choke able). Spread out the items so they can be organized into categories. First choose one item and glue it down. Then choose two of another item and glue it down, then three then four etc. until you have rows of items to count. Starting with a row of only five items is good for the beginner counters.
