Mix flour, salt and cornstarch in bowl. Add warm water slowly until dough starts to clump together. Knead into a large ball. Dries very hard in 48 hours. Keeps at least 4 weeks refrigerated. To make beads, roll small balls of dough and pierce with a toothpick. Paint and string dry beads to make necklaces.
