- **Puzzles**

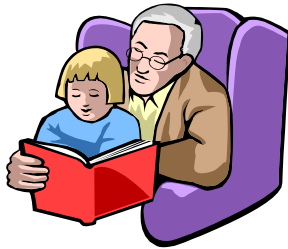
You will need:

You and your child can draw a picture from the story. Use the entire piece of paper. Cut the picture into four or five pieces. Mix up all the pieces and then put your very own puzzle together. Store in a zip lock baggie so you can use it again and again.

- **Mouse Books**



You will need:

- Crayons
- Scissors
- Stapler
- Pencil
- Duplicated booklet

Directions:

First, color the pictures on the duplicated pages. Cut on the lines. Staple on the edge so that the pages align on the bottom of the booklet. Think of what may happen if a mouse is given the items in the booklet. Write your responses on the bottom of the pages, and you have just created your own book!
