



• **Alphabet Bingo**

Prepare a set of Bingo game cards (with letters instead of numbers) out of construction paper. Make a set of alphabet cards to use for calling out the letters during the game. Use small squares of paper or buttons for markers. Your children will enjoy playing Bingo with you as they learn about the alphabet!



• **Alphabet Cookies**

Using your child's favorite cookie recipe, form letters with the dough and watch them grow in the oven. If you have alphabet cookie cutters, get them out too! (Or use play-dough!)

Tips for reading to young children:

- Make reading time a special time by snuggling and cuddling.
- Read books that your child can safely handle.
- Read anything that you enjoy reading.
- Model reading as an adult.
