





- **Snow Crackers**

Equipment: Large baking sheet
Rotary beater or electric mixer (**supervise electric mixer**)
Medium sized bowl

Ingredients: 24 soda crackers
2 egg whites
¼ cup sugar
¼ teaspoon vanilla

Directions: Arrange on a baking sheet, 24 soda crackers. Beat 2 egg whites with a rotary beater until frothy. Gradually beat in ¼ cup sugar and beat until stiff. Stir in ¼ teaspoon of vanilla. Spoon “snow” onto crackers. Spread to the edge of each cracker. (**ADULT**) Bake at 400 degrees for 6 to 8 minutes. Bake until golden brown. Toaster ovens work great for this recipe.
